### Training & Employee Readiness

### Regulatory Compliance

Identify areas where practices, programs, and documentation fall short of OSHA standards.

## Process

### 1 Kickoff & Data Collection

Align objectives, confirm logistics, and collect required documents and site information.

### 2 Site Evaluation

Conduct visual inspections, observe work practices, and interview staff to validate conditions.

### 4 Report Action Plan

Deliver the OSHA Assessment Report and a prioritized Corrective Action Plan with timelines and verification steps.

### 3 Analysis & Prioritization

Map findings to OSHA standards, rate risk severity, and identify root causes where applicable.

## FMS Deliverables

- OSHA Assessment Report: Executive summary, hazards, compliance gaps, photos, and recommended corrective actions.
- Corrective Action Plan: Prioritized matrix with responsible parties, timelines, and verification methods.
- Optional Add-Ons: Program development, employee training, follow-up visits, or OSHA inspection support.
